

# BOSTON RED SOX GAME NOTES

## BOSTON RED SOX (24-18) at BALTIMORE ORIOLES (20-19)

**ABOUT THE SOX:** The Red Sox conclude this 3-city, 10-day roadtrip today with the only day game on the trip...Boston has lost 3 consecutive games since winning in Minnesota on Saturday, matching its 2nd longest losing streak of 2008 (5, April 22-27; 3, May 4-6)...Club has dropped 4 of 5 and 5 of 7 and is 4-5 on this trip to Detroit (3-1), Minnesota (1-3), and Baltimore (0-1).

► Boston is 7-5 since May 2, has won 9 of 15 beginning April 29 and has captured 15 of 26 since April 17.

► At 24-18 (.571), the Red Sox have dropped to 6 games above .500 for the 1<sup>st</sup> time since May 3 (19-13)...Boston now has 4<sup>th</sup> best winning percentage in the A.L...Are the team's fewest wins after 42 contests since 2005 (24-18/24-18)...Sox were 29-13 (30-13) in 2007.

► The Red Sox are 8-10 against A.L. East foes, ending a 3-game win streak on Tuesday...Club has captured 5 of 7 against the A.L. East.

**AWAY FROM HOME:** The Red

Sox have matched their longest road losing streak of the season with 3 straight defeats since winning in Minnesota on Saturday...Boston has dropped 5 of its last 8 on the road and is 10-13 overall, its fewest victories after 23 away games since 1997 (9-14/9-15 after 24 games)...Sox were 15-8/16-8 in 2007.

► Of Boston's last 8 road defeats, 6 have been by one run with 3 being walk-off losses.

► The Red Sox are 1-8 in A.L. East parks and have dropped 4 in a row since recording its lone victory on April 17 at Yankee Stadium.

**IN THE STANDINGS:** Over the last 5 days (1-4), the Red Sox have gone from having a 3.5 game advantage in the A.L. East to trailing Tampa Bay by a half game...This is the 1<sup>st</sup> time that the Red Sox have not occupied the top spot since May 1, when it trailed by percentage points...Boston had held 1<sup>st</sup> place or been within percentage points of 1<sup>st</sup> place for 28 consecutive days beginning April 15 and last had a deficit in terms of games on April 14 (0.5 GB)...Sox have held sole possession of 1<sup>st</sup> in the East for 24 total days, including 11 straight before Tuesday.

**TERRY FRANCONA** is missing the 2-game series in Baltimore...Mary Ann Lang, the mother of his wife, Jacque, passed away on Monday night in Tucson, Arizona...Francona and his family flew to Tucson on Tuesday...He is expected to be in uniform for Friday's game with Milwaukee at Fenway Park.

► The Red Sox are 5-4 in the 9 games Francona has missed since he became manager of the club in 2004...Bench coach Brad Mills has been at the helm for all 9: April 6-10, 2005...Missed 4 games with viral illness...Team was 2-2 April 29-May 1, 2005...Missed 3 games due to MLB suspension...Team was 2-1 June 13, 2005...Missed one game due to daughter's HS graduation...Team was 1-0 May 13-14...Will miss 2 games due to passing of mother-in-law.

**PRODUCTIVE OFFENSE:** The Red Sox are batting .327 (146-446) with 77 runs, 38 doubles, and 17 homers in the last 12 games to raise team average from .278 to .293, the highest in the majors by 10 points (Atlanta-.283)...This is the Red Sox' best batting average through 42 games since 2002 at .298 (.305 through 43 games).

► Sox had produced at least 11 hits in all 11 contests of this span before being held to 9 on Tuesday...The 11 straight games of 10+ hits was the Sox' longest such streak since 13 in a row, May 6-19, 1999.

► Boston leads the majors with 428 hits, 97 doubles, 143 extra base hits, and 658 total bases and also tops the American League with 213 runs, a .450 slugging percentage, and a .364 on-base percentage.

► Boston also tops the majors with a .284 road batting average and ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> with 28 homers away from home, 4 fewer than Florida.

**DAY BASEBALL:** This is the only day game on this 10-day roadtrip and just the Red Sox' 2<sup>nd</sup> day contest in the last 16 games...Boston is 6-4 in the daytime in 2008...Club is 1-4 on then road, losing the last 4 since the lone victory on April 2 in Oakland.

► Boston leads the majors with a .302 batting average, .456 slugging percentage, and .384 on-base percentage in day games...Sox have 3 of the A.L.'s top 10 in day average: Kevin Youkilis, 1<sup>st</sup> at .467; Jason Varitek, 5<sup>th</sup> at .375, and Dustin Pedroia, 10<sup>th</sup> at .366...Club is 8<sup>th</sup> in the league with a 3.83 day ERA.

### MANNY VS. THE ORIOLES

Manny Ramirez drove in his 145<sup>th</sup> career run against the Orioles on Tuesday, 4<sup>th</sup> most in history versus that club since the franchise moved from St. Louis to Baltimore for the 1954 season:

### THE RED SOX AND ORIOLES

**2008/TRENDS:** Boston has won 5 of last 7 and is 27-10 versus Baltimore since the start of 2006...Boston has captured 32 of 42 games vs. the Birds beginning Sept. 3, 2005 and holds a 102-73 edge since 1997.

**AT CAMDEN YARDS:** Since losing 3 of 4 here from July 7-10, 2005, Boston has won 16 of 22 games and has not dropped consecutive contests...The Red Sox are 54-24 here since the start of 1999, winning the last 9 season's series in Baltimore.

**ALL-TIME:** Boston is 467-401 against the Orioles (beginning 1954), 236-195 at Fenway Park and 231-206 in Baltimore (75-45 at Oriole Park since 1992)...Sox have not lost all games of a series in Baltimore since going 0-4, July 9-12, 1998, and have not dropped both games in a 2-game series here since August 4-5, 1970.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Red Sox today recalled OF Jonathan Van Every from Triple-A Pawtucket...Van Every, 27, will be making his major league debut...He is batting .287 with 6 homers and 20 RBI in 40 games with the Paw Sox while not committing an error as the club's CF...He was signed as a free agent and added to the major league roster this winter...Van Every will be the 34<sup>th</sup> player to be on the 2008 active roster.

► To make room for Van Every, RHP Clay Buchholz has been placed on the 15-day DH, retroactive in May 13, with a broken nail on his right middle finger...Buchholz sustained the injury in Monday night's start at Minnesota...RHP Josh Beckett will start the versus Milwaukee on Sunday.

**INTERLEAGUE PLAY BEGINS:** The Red Sox open 2008 play vs. the National League with a 3-game series against the Milwaukee Brewers at Fenway Park this weekend.

► Boston was 12-6 (.667) in interleague play in 2007, tying for the 3<sup>rd</sup> best winning percentage in the A.L...Sox are 28-8 (.778) the last 2 years, 2<sup>nd</sup> in the majors behind Detroit at .806 (29-7).

► This will be the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting between the Red Sox and Brewers since Boston won the final 2 of a 3-game set, June 6-8, 2003 at Miller Park...It will be Milwaukee's 1<sup>st</sup> trip to Boston since 1997, the Brewers' last A.L. season, when the Sox won 4 of 5 in 2 series, last on September 7.

**JONATHAN PAPELTON** has pitched 15.1 career scoreless innings vs. Baltimore...Only 3 pitchers in history have more career scoreless innings vs. the O's: 25.2—Steve Olin; 18.2—Jeff Tam; 16.0—Jesus Sanchez.

**SHORTS:** The Red Sox have lost 3-run leads each of the last 2 nights to match their biggest margin in a loss this season...That happened once in the 1<sup>st</sup> 40 games...Sox starters have allowed 5+ runs in 3 straight games for the 1<sup>st</sup> time since April 20-22, 2007... Club has been successful on 24 of their last 25 stolen base tries beginning April 20.

**TODAY'S RED SOX STARTING PITCHER**

**31-JON LESTER, LHP**

**2008:** 2-2, 4.06 ERA (23 ER/51.0 IP) in 9 GS  
**CAREER:** 13-4, 4.52 ERA (98 ER/195.1 IP) in 36 G, 35 GS  
**2008 SPRING TRAINING:** 1-0, 6.00 ERA (8 ER/12.0 IP) in 4 starts

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his 9<sup>th</sup> start of the season on May 9 at Minnesota...Allowed 5 runs (3 earned) on 8 hits and one walk and struck out 2 over 5.1 innings but did not figure in Boston's 7-6 loss...Was leading, 6-5, when he was replaced by David Aardsma with one out in the 6<sup>th</sup>, but did not get the win as Jonathan Papelbon blew a save for the 2<sup>nd</sup> straight game.

► Lester has allowed 3 earned runs or less in each of his last 3 starts, going 1-0 with a 1.86 ERA (4 ER/19.1 IP) in that time...He has tossed at least 5.0 innings in 5 straight starts posting a 3.23 ERA (11 ER/30.2 IP) over that stretch...He has not lost since April 9 vs. Detroit, a span of 6 starts during which he has gone 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA (15 ER/35.0 IP)

**ONE TOUGH INNING:** He has allowed 7 of his 23 runs this season in just 2 innings, 4 runs in the 4<sup>th</sup> on April 9 vs. Detroit and 3 runs in the 3<sup>rd</sup> on March 23 at Oakland in the Tokyo Dome...Without those 2 frames he has posted a 2.94 ERA (16 ER/49.0 IP).

**WINNING WAYS:** He is 13-4 (.765) in 36 career games (35 starts)...Since 1900, that ranks as the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest career winning percentage in major league history among pitchers with at least 25 career starts...Only Howie Krist (.771), who went 37-11 with the Cardinals from 1937-46, ranks higher...Has taken a no-decision in 18 of his 35 major league starts.

**TAKING THE HILL:** Lester is tied for the American League lead with 9 starts...He makes his 10<sup>th</sup> start today in Boston's 43<sup>rd</sup> game of the year...Since 1956, only 6 other left-handers have started at least 10 of the club's first 42 contests: Frank Viola (10 in 1992), Bruce Hurst (10 in 1984, 1986-88), John Tudor (10 in 1983), Bill Lee (12 in 1975, 11 in 1974), Gary Peters (10 in 1970-71) and Dick Ellsworth (10 in 1968).

**PREVIOUS START:** Made his 8<sup>th</sup> start on May 4 vs. Tampa Bay...Allowed one run on 4 hits and 3 walks and struck out 5 in 6.0 innings to earn the 7-3 victory, his first since April 2 at Oakland, a span of 5 starts...The one run allowed came on a homer by Carlos Pena in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning, ending a string of 13.0 scoreless frames for Lester.

**MORE 2008:** Made his 7<sup>th</sup> start of the season on April 29 vs. Toronto, matching career best marks of 8.0 innings pitched, no runs and 1 hit allowed...Walked 4 and struck out 6...Left in a scoreless game after 8.0 innings and did not factor into the decision in the eventual 1-0 walk-off win on a 2-out RBI single by Kevin Youkilis in the bottom of the 9<sup>th</sup>...Retired the first 11 batters he faced before walking Vernon Wells in the 4<sup>th</sup>...Made his 6<sup>th</sup> start of the season on April 23 against the Angels at Fenway Park...Was not scheduled to start that game but was pressed into service when Daisuke Matsuzaka was scratched due to illness...It was his 1<sup>st</sup> career start on 3 days rest...Allowed 4 runs on 9 hits and 2 walks and struck out one in 5.0 innings...Left with the score tied at 4-4 but did not figure in the decision as the Angels went on to win, 6-4...Allowed a pair of homers to Gary Matthews Jr, a 2-run shot in the 1<sup>st</sup> inning and a solo blast in the 5<sup>th</sup>...Allowed 3 runs on 10 hits and 2 walks while fanning 5 in 6.1 innings on April 19 vs. Texas...Left trailing 3-2 but got off the hook as Boston scored 3 times in the 8<sup>th</sup>, including 2 runs on a Manny Ramirez homer, and won, 5-3...Gave up 4 runs on 5 hits and struck out 3 in 4.1 innings on April 14 at Cleveland...Matched a career high with 5 walks, done for the 3<sup>rd</sup> time, the 1<sup>st</sup> since July 13, 2006...Was relieved by Julian Tavarez in the 5<sup>th</sup> trailing 4-0, but did not take the loss as the Red Sox rallied for all 6 of their runs over the game's final 3 innings, including a game-winning 2-run homer by Manny Ramirez with 2 outs in the top of the 9<sup>th</sup>.

**LAST YEAR:** Went 3-0 with a 3.64 ERA (17 ER/42.0 IP) in his final 8 games (7 starts) for Boston, including a 2-0 record and 3.34 ERA (11 ER/29.2 IP) in his last 6 outings (5 starts)...Recalled from Triple-A Pawtucket on July 23 for his first major league stint of 2007...Began the year on the D.L. and was sent to Single-A Greenville on rehab assignment on April 5...Made 3 starts for the Drive, posting a 2.08 ERA (3 ER/13.0 IP)...Sent to Pawtucket to continue rehabbing on April 27 and was 0-1, 2.25 (2 ER/8.0 IP) before experiencing muscle cramping in his left forearm on May 2 vs. Indianapolis...Recalled from the rehab assignment after that start and spent the next 2 weeks undergoing treatment before beginning a 2nd rehab stint with the PawSox...Activated from the D.L. on June 11 and optioned to Pawtucket, where he went 4-5 with a 3.89 ERA in 14 starts overall.

**CAREER NOTES:** Lester successfully completed his comeback from a battle with lymphoma during the previous offseason...Spent most of the 2nd half of 2007 with Boston, but also had stints with 3 of the Sox' minor league affiliates while working his way back from treatments...The No. 1 prospect in Boston's system going into the 2006 season, according to *Baseball America*, Lester reached the majors that year in just his 5th pro campaign...Began his big league career with a 5-0 record and was 7-2 before seeing his season cut short due to the anaplastic large cell lymphoma diagnosis in late August 2006...After undergoing treatment, was pronounced cancer-free in December 2006...Had his best minor league season in 2005, named Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Red Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Year for Double-A Portland.

**VS. BALTIMORE:** Has won all 3 of his career starts against the O's, posting a 3.00 ERA (6 ER/18.0 IP) in those contests, including a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) in his last 2 games...Allowed 4 hits, 2 walks and fanned 4 over 7.0 scoreless frames in his last start, September 7, 2007 at Camden Yards.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his 8<sup>th</sup> start of the season on May 10 at Minnesota...Allowed 2 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks and struck out 7 over 7.0 innings to beat Glen Perkins and the Twins, 5-2...The Red Sox were trailing 2-1 in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning before back-to-back homers by Coco Crisp and Jed Lowrie put them on top for good...With the win, Matsuzaka improved to 6-0 in his first 7 starts, tied for the longest winning streak in the A.L. this season.

► Since 1956, Matsuzaka is the 15<sup>th</sup> Red Sox pitcher to begin a season 6-0, the first since Josh Beckett went 9-0 to start last year...He is unbeaten in his last 11 starts beginning September 14, 2007, going 7-0 with a 2.91 ERA (22 ER/68.0 IP), 4<sup>th</sup>-best among A.L. starters (min 60 IP) in that time.

► Boston is 10-0 in his last 10 starts dating back to September 22, 2007...It is the longest team winning streak of his career and the longest for a Red Sox pitcher since the club won 11 of Bronson Arroyo's starts in a row from August 21, 2005 to April 14, 2005.

**VS. MILWAUKEE:** Friday will be his first career start against the Brewers.
