**RECENT RESULTS:** The Tigers completed a three-game sweep of the Texas Rangers with an 8-2 win at Comerica Park yesterday afternoon, the club's eighth win in its last 11 games. Magglio Ordonez belted two home runs and drove in four runs to lead the Tigers attack, while Curtis Granderson, Brandon Inge and Ryan Raburn all added a solo home run. It marked the fourth time the Tigers have connected for five-or-more home runs in Comerica Park history. Zach Miner (1-1) picked up the win in relief for Detroit, tossing 3.1 scoreless innings. The Tigers continue their six-game homestand with the first game of a three-game series against the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim this evening.

**RUNS ABOUND AT COMERICA PARK:** The Tigers have scored 37 runs in the club's last three games, marking the most runs scored by the Tigers in a three-game stretch since the club scored 47 runs August 10-12, 1993. Detroit has won each of its last five games at home, scoring a total of 54 runs during the winning streak. Tigers hitters have combined to hit .341 (58x170) with 12 doubles, three triples and 15 home runs in the last five games at Comerica Park.

**WINNING WAYS:** Detroit posted its eighth win in the club's last 11 games yesterday afternoon against Texas. During the 11-game stretch dating back to April 14, the Tigers are hitting .304 (116x381) with 86 runs scored, 28 doubles, three triples and 19 home runs. The Tigers are leading all American League clubs with 86 runs scored, 19 home runs and a .543 slugging percentage during this stretch, while they are second with a .304 batting average.

**MAGGLIO MASHES AGAINST ANGELS:** Magglio Ordonez enters the game tonight against the Angels with a .329 batting average (95x289) in 74 games against the club, while he has collected 16 doubles, a triple, 21 home runs and 56 RBI. Ordonez is second among all active major league players with a .609 slugging percentage against the Angels, while he is third with a home run once every 13.76 at-bats and fifth with a .329 batting average.

**BULLISH BEHAVIOR:** Over the club's last seven games, Tigers relievers have compiled a 0.72 ERA (25.0IP/2ER). During the seven-game stretch, opposing batters have hit .157 (13x83) against club relievers. Detroit's bullpen has not been scored upon in its last 12.0 innings of work dating back to Tuesday night versus Texas.

**WALK THIS WAY:** The Tigers collected five walks yesterday against the Rangers, and the club is leading the American League with 103 walks through its first 23 games of the season. Tigers hitters have drawn five-or-more walks in each of the club's last five games, including a season-high 10 walks on Wednesday night versus Texas. The Tigers have drawn five-or-more walks 11 times so far in 2008. Detroit did not record its 11th five-or-walk game until June 1 during the 2007 season, the club's 54th game of the season.

**RENTERIA'S RED HOT:** Edgar Renteria has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games dating back to April 9. During that stretch, Renteria is batting .403 (25x62) with 14 runs scored, five doubles, three home runs and 14 RBI. He is tied for the American League lead during that stretch with 25 hits, while he is second with a .403 batting average, fourth with a .629 slugging percentage and tied for fifth with 14 RBI.

**HAPPY AT HOME:** In 73 games at Comerica Park dating back to May 10, 2007, Magglio Ordonez is hitting .400 (110x275) with 62 runs scored, 25 doubles, 19 home runs and 69 RBI. He has reached base safely via a hit or walk in 67 of the games.

**LEADING OFF IN GRAND STYLE:** Curtis Granderson connected for his 14th career lead-off home run yesterday afternoon against the Texas Rangers. With the lead-off home run, Granderson now holds sole possession of third place all-time in Tigers history (snapped a tie with Tony Phillips). Only Lou Whitaker (23) and Dick McAuliffe (19) have homered to lead off a game more times than Granderson in Tigers history.

**MULTI-RBI MAGGLIO:** Magglio Ordonez posted his fourth multi-RBI game of the season yesterday against the Rangers, driving in four runs. It marked the 82nd time since he joined the Tigers in 2005 that Ordonez has driven in at least two runs in a game. The Tigers have posted a 61-21 record in the 82 games.

**CRUCETA'S ASSIGNMENT TO TRIPLE A TOLEDO:** Francisco Cruceta made his first appearance with Triple A Toledo on Tuesday night, working three scoreless innings and striking out six batters. Cruceta was assigned to Toledo prior to Tuesday's game and the assignment can last a maximum of 16 days. Cruceta was signed by the Tigers as a free agent on November 30, 2007.

**NOTES ON NATE:** In his fifth full season with the Tigers, Robertson makes his fifth start of the season this evening against the Angels.

**LONG-TERM DEAL:** Robertson agreed to a three-year contract during the off-season, keeping him in a Tigers uniform through the 2010 season.

**PROUD PAPA:** Robertson and his wife, Kristin, welcomed the couple's first child on February 28, a baby boy named Wyatt Dale.

**MOVING UP THE TIGERS LEFTY LIST:** Robertson is making his 139th start as a member of the Detroit Tigers this evening, moving him past Hank Aguirre (138) for sole possession of ninth place among left-handed pitchers in franchise history. Robertson is one of only 16 lefthanded pitchers in club history to surpass 100 starts in a Tigers uniform.

**TAKING THE BALL EVERY FIFTH DAY:** Since the start of the 2004 season, Robertson has started 130 games for the Tigers. During that stretch, he is fifth among all American League pitchers with the 130 games started. Additionally, Robertson is eighth in the league with 801.1 innings pitched during the stretch.

**RECORD AT COMERICA PARK:** Robertson is making his 74th appearance, 73rd start, at Comerica Park during his career tonight against the Angels. In his previous 73 outings, he is 22-26 with a 4.37 ERA (445.1IP/216ER).

**LIMITING THE LEFTIES:** During his major league career, Robertson has limited lefties to a .253 batting average (189x748). During that stretch, he has held lefties to a .301 on-base percentage and .352 slugging percentage.

**LIMITING THE LEFTIES, PART II:** Since the start of the 2004 season, Robertson has held lefthanded opposition to a .248 batting average (176x709). During that same stretch, Robertson has surrendered only nine home runs to lefthanded hitters, tied for third-fewest in the American League during that stretch. The following is a list of the top six league pitchers in fewest home runs allowed to lefthanded batters since the start of the 2004 season (minimum of 500 batters faced):
