THE FISH: The Marlins today play the first of three at Washington, the first of a 10-game trip to Washington (3g), Pittsburgh (4g), Tampa (3g). The Marlins went 3-4 on their recent homestand against the Padres (1-2) and Dodgers (2-2). The Fish will have an off day after this trip, then will begin a six-game homestand against Philly (May 22-24) and the Mets (May 25-27).

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Henry Owens placed on the 15-day DL (retroactive May 9) with right shoulder rotator cuff tendinitis. OF John Gall was selected from Albuquerque (AAA), where he batted .307 (39x127), 3 HR, 15 RBI in 34 games.

AGAINST THE NATIONALS: The Marlins and Nationals today will play the first of a three-game series in DC, the seventh of 18 between the clubs this season. The Fish are 4-2 (2-1 road) this year and 115-100 (56-50 road) all-time against the Nationals/Expos. They are 24-18 (12-9 at RFK) since the Expos became the Nationals.

YESTERDAY: Florida beat the Dodgers 3-0 at Dolphin Stadium. Josh Willingham broke a scoreless tie in the bottom of the ninth with a three-run walkoff homer off Derek Lowe, scoring Hanley Ramirez and Dan Uggla. LHP Taylor Tankersley (2-0) earned the win with a perfect ninth inning. RHP Sergio Mitre made the start and held the Dodgers scoreless on three hits through 8.0 innings.

WALK IT OFF: Josh Willingham hit a three-run walkoff home run yesterday off Derek Lowe. The Marlins have had just two walkoff homers in the last three years, both by Willingham. His other came 8/1/06 vs. the Mets, a two-run shot off Billy Wagner. Prior to that, the Marlins had endured the longest stretch in the Majors between walkoff home runs (Mike Lowell, 5/29/04 vs. Mets).

NATIONAL THREAT: Miguel Cabrera has hit in his last 12 games against the Nationals, batting .605 (26x43), 5 HR, 16 RBI over that stretch. He has homered in his last two and four of his last five against the Nats. During his career, Cabrera has only had one longer hit streak against an opponent, 17 straight vs. Pittsburgh from 7/6/05 to 7/22/06.

MC AT RFK: Miguel Cabrera has hit .458 for his career at RFK Stadium. The following are the ballparks at which Cabrera has had his highest career batting averages: Chase Field (.471/ 16x34 in 9g), RFK Stadium (.458/ 38x83 in 21g), Great American (.457/ 16x35 in 9g).

BETTER TO LEAD...: The Fish lead the NL with 176 runs. The Marlins have struck out 299 times this season, tops in the Majors. The last team to finish the season leading the league in both runs scored and strikeouts was the 2005 Reds (820 R, 1,303 K).

GIVING THE RUNAROUND: The Marlins have scored 176 runs this year and are on pace for 839 runs. The '06 Fish set a club record with 758 runs.

ON THE SHORT LIST: Hanley Ramirez is tied with Jimmy Rollins for the NL lead with 32 runs. Jose Reyes is third with 31 runs – thus the top three in the league for runs scored are all shortstops in the NL East. Ramirez and Rollins are tied for second in the MLB, behind Alex Rodriguez (35 R).

SLOW STARTERS: The Marlins have not recorded a first-inning hit and have been outscored 13-1 in the first four innings during their last five games. Over that span, the Fish have outscored opponents 13-6 after the fourth inning. They are 2-3 over their last five games.

MINOR MATTERS: The Marlins today named Dante Brinkley their Minor League Player of the Month for April. He batted .378 (31x82), 6 HR, 15 RBI, 11 SB in 23 games between Jupiter (A) and Carolina (AA). The Pitcher of the Month was Graham Taylor, who went 4-1, 3.90 ERA in five starts with Greensboro (A). He recorded just 1 BB with 26 SO.

PITCHING IN: Marlins pitchers are batting .219 (14x64), second in the NL behind the Mets (.221). Florida pitchers have 14 hits, second behind the Mets (15). Scott Olsen leads all Major League pitchers with 6 hits.

THE PEN IS MIGHTIER...: Florida's bullpen earned the win yesterday, and has earned the decision in each of the team's last three wins. Below is a breakdown of the bullpen's recent success:

RUNNING WITH THE BULL: The Marlins' bullpen has logged 130.0 innings this season, most in the Majors. The Fish bullpen is 4-8, 3.81 ERA. The pen has converted 7-of-13 save opps. Below are the bullpens that have logged the most innings in the Majors this season:

EXTRA, EXTRA: The Marlins lead the Majors with 126 extra-base hits. Florida had 102 extra-base hits in April, a new club record for extra-base hits in any month. The Marlins became the first team since the 2004 Cardinals (104 XBH) to record 100+ XBH in April. *The Fish have at least one XBH in each game this season.*

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Miguel Cabrera is in sole possession of fifth place on the Marlins all-time home run list with 112 HR. He is just eight homers from tying Jeff Conine for fourth:

ON THE DL: The Marlins have eight players on the DL: RH Jose Garcia (elbow inflammation), RH Josh Johnson (right elbow), RH Logan Kensing (Tommy John Surgery), RH Carlos Martinez (Tommy John Surgery), Jeremy Hermida (bone bruise, right knee), all retro to March 23. OF Alejandro De Aza went on April 18 (retro 4/16) with a sprained right ankle. OF Cody Ross went on Sunday with a left hamstring strain, and RHP Henry Owens went on today (retro May 9) with right shoulder rotator cuff tendonitis.

SCHEDULE UPDATES: The Marlins and Braves will play a split-admission doubleheader on June 5 in Atlanta, playing the regularly scheduled game plus the game that was ppd on Saturday (April 14). The first game will start at 2:35 pm, followed by a 7:35 pm game... The Marlins game in Tampa on May 18 was changed to a 6:40 pm start (was 7:15 pm).

AUCTION: The Florida Marlins are auctioning off a game-used base from 2007 Opening Day to benefit the Hokie Spirit Memorial Fund. The base, which includes the Opening Day Major League Baseball Logo, is signed by the entire Marlins team, and can be bid on at www.floridamarlins.com. The Hokie Spirit Memorial Fund was established to remember and honor the victims of the tragic on-campus events of April 16 at Virginia Tech and to aid the healing process.

ALL-STAR BALLOTING: Voting for the 2007 MLB All-Star Game is under way. Fans can pick up ballots in several locations on both the 100 and 200 levels. Stadium personnel will distribute All-Star ballots in the second inning of the game and will collect those forms in the top of the fourth inning. Marlins fans are also encouraged to cast their votes online at the team's official website, www.floridamarlins.com.

OLSEN HIGHLIGHTS

• In his last outing, Olsen suffered his second loss of the season, dropping a 3-1 decision to Jake Peavy and the San Diego Padres. Peavy out-dueled Olsen, taking a no-hitter into the sixth inning. Olsen only allowed four hits in 100 pitches. It was his lowest hit total in an outing since April 8 against Philadelphia.

• Of Olsen's five career starts at RFK Stadium, his only loss came on April 15, 2006, his first outing against Washington. Since then he is 2-0 with a 4.43 ERA in four starts and his holding the Nationals to a .264 batting average. He has allowed 13 runs, while the Marlins have supported Olsen with 18 runs in those four starts. He is averaging 7.8 K/9 IP in his career against the Nationals.

• Olsen compiled a record of 5-7 with a 4.37 ERA at Dolphin Stadium in 2006. Opponents hit .255 off Olsen and struck out 90 times. In comparison, on the road he led all Marlins pitchers with a 7-3 record, 3.70 ERA, and 76 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .221 batting average. He gave up 14 home runs on the road, as opposed to just nine at Dolphin Stadium.

• Was 1-4 with a 4.63 ERA in six starts in Spring Training. Finished with 17 K in 23.1 IP... Walked 11 and gave up 25 hits... batters hit .272 off Olsen in the Grapefruit league.

• Olsen set a new franchise record for strikeouts by a rookie on September 8, 2006 against Philadelphia; he fanned 166 opposing batters in 2006, trumping Dontrelle Willis' 2003 mark of 142. He finished the 2006 season with an average of 8.3 strikeouts per nine innings.

• Olsen finished the 2006 season in a three-way tie with teammate Josh Johnson and Minnesota's Francisco Liriano for third place in the Majors in rookie wins with 12. Detroit's Justin Verlander set the bar with 17 wins followed by San Francisco's Matt Cain (13)...He finished second in rookie ERA behind Verlander (3.63)...He also finished second in rookie strikeouts, behind Cain (175).

• After going 4x7 at the plate in four starts from April 15-30, Olsen is currently hitting at a .500 clip, with a double and two RBI on the season. Olsen has only 20 strikeouts in 73 at-bats in his career. He is 5x12 (.417) against Nationals pitchers in his career.

• Olsen has hit safely in five of his seven starts this season. He is batting .500 (6x12), which leads all ML pitchers, and has 2 RBI, tied for most among pitchers. The Marlins single-season record for batting average by a pitcher is .271 by Chris Hammond in 1995 (13x48). Olsen finished April with a .545 batting average. According to STATS, Inc., only one active pitcher since 1957 finished April (min. 10 PA) with a higher average than Olsen: Dontrelle Willis hit .583 (7x12) in April, 2004.
